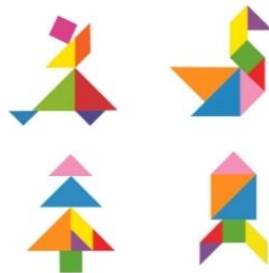
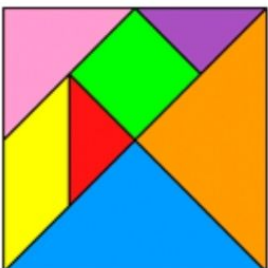
READ GENESIS 27:11-19

## FAMILYACTIVITY "TANGRAM OF GRACE"

Prepare: Tangram template, color pencils or markers, scissor.

1. On the back of each piece of Tangram, write down some of your sin or weakness. On the front side, color it with color pencils and markers. Say these colors symbolize the grace of God.
2. Cut out the tangram pieces and put together to make various figures of person, animal or objects. Talk about how God is able to create something beautiful out of our weaknesses and brokenness of sin.



God has a wonderful plan for all of us even though we do not deserve it. Jacob did not deserve God's blessings at all. He tricked and lied to steal the blessings from Esau and as a result he had to leave his beloved family for so many years. When we look at ourselves, we are just as bad as Jacob in many ways. Yet, we find that God is gracious. He chooses to bless us as He transforms us along the way because He loves us.

God carries out His wonderful plan even in troubled families. Jacob's family had lots of troubles. There was a favoritism, and the mom and the son worked together to lie and cheat. Think about some troubles in your family that discourage you. Do you think God is aware of this? Do you think He still has a wonderful plan for your family?

God carries out His wonderful plan even to those who are not trustworthy. Jacob was definitely not trustworthy but he learned his own lesson later as he himself was tricked by his uncle Laban. Shaping and molding Him to be a better person was part of God's wonderful plan for him.

God carries out His wonderful plan even to those who are in despair. Jacob was in despair when he had to run away from angry brother Esau. He felt like he had no future. But God met Jacob when he was afraid and powerless. God promised that He will bless him not because of his good works but because of His perfect plan, and His love and grace for Jacob.

In the same way, God decided to bless and offer us a wonderful plan in our lives not because we are good or that we deserve any of it, but because God is good and gracious. And in order to do that, He will make sure to change and transform us to be fit and ready for His wonderful plan.
