FAMILY ACTIVITY "SEE THROUGH FAITH"

Prepare: A large paper shopping bag, sharp pencil or ball point pen, 4-5 thick straw, Any objects to observe (ex: teddy bear, toilet paper roll, tissue, book or any object

that will fit within the paper bag).

1. Poke 4-5 holes into the paper bag using the pencil or ball point pen in different places. Stick a straw through the holes.
2. Place object into the bags and make sure no one can see what it is. Have people guess what the objects are only by looking through the straws.
3. Change the object and repeat.

(Summary) Seeing the object through a straw is like living our everyday life with our own narrow perspective. When we can see the whole picture of God with the eyes of faith, we will be able to understand the work of God.

God had promised Israelites since the time of Abraham, that He will make His people into a great nation and pour our His blessings. The time has come for them to finally enter the Promised Land but they could not fully trust God because of the things they saw in the land. The consequence of the lack of faith was miserable.

Lack of faith makes us depend on ourselves instead of God.

The twelve spies indeed saw the rich resources that were full in the Promised Land. But they stumbled over the enemies in the land. They started to calculate whether they will be able to win the enemy instead of depending on God to fight. They decided they will not win, because they just could not trust God enough.

Lack of faith makes you forget the powerful work of the Lord and His promises from the past.

As people let go of faith in God, they started to shake in fear. They lost the sense of judgment. They completely forgot what God had done for them in the past at the Red Sea and in the midst of wilderness journey. They did not remember the promised God has given them.

- 2. What are some of your greatest fears?**
- 3. Take this time to pray for one another, so that we will remember His promises in our lives and overcome our fears.**
