Opening Scripture Read 2 Corinthians 10:12-18 together.

Understanding Background

Paul was an apostle who received a calling for the mission to the Gentiles and pioneered Corinth church during a second mission trip. However, the Jews and false apostles infiltrated the Corinth church inconspicuously and opposed Paul. They criticized Paul saying he had a poor appearance and his sermon was horrible all the while boasting themselves. Corinthians being misled false apostles' words (2Corinthians 11:4), misjudged Paul as a foreign enemy. Towards this, Paul declared that self-praising is foolish and there is nothing to boast about oneself; But "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord."

> Study

1-1. Observation & Reflection According to Paul, what standards were used to by the false apostles to praise themselves? And what is the outcome/result of their self-praising (v. 12)?

1-2. Application & Sharing) What would be rooted psychologically in self-praising? What can you do to avoid such temptation?

2-1. Observation & Reflection What counsel does Paul provide to those apostles who falsely take credit for hard work performed by others as their own (v. 17~18)?

2-2. Application & Sharing] what would be considered a healthy praise/boasting that's based on faith? And how can we apply it to our daily lives?

> Key Points

It is foolish to raise our stature by using our own standards. Standards of disciples of Christ should be that of Jesus who obeyed by humbling/lowering himself even to death. False apostles criticized and attacked Paul by exposing his weaknesses. They tried to elevate their stature by snatching Paul's achievements/merits as their own. Elevating and boasting oneself stems from a great desire to be recognized by others. God is the one recognizes and praises our efforts. Eternal reward for disciples of Christ is not self-praise or praises from other people but God's recognition and praise. Those who wishes to boast should boast "in Christ" and for "the glory of God".

Prayer through the Word] Everything in my life is by God's Grace. Please help me not to commit sin of self-boasting or taking credit for other people's work. Please allow Jesus to be my only joy and my praise.

To Keep in the heart But "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord" For it is not the one who commends himself who is approved, but the one whom the Lord commends." [2 Corinthians 10:17~18, ESV]
