Word I

Understanding the background

Solomon was the king of Israel with the greatest wisdom and riches in the kingdom of Israel. He was buried in Gibeon at the sacrifice of Gibeon in the early days of his reign (1 Chron., That night I hear God's voice, "What shall I give you" (2 Chronicles 1: 7).

Share the Word

1-1. Observe and meditate? In what process does Solomon hear the voice of God? (V. 6)

1-2. Observation and Meditation | What did Solomon ask God, who came to him? (V. 10)

1-3. Applying and Sharing | What am I doing to God these days and why? Why do I ask to hear God's voice before I ask?

2-1. **Observation and meditation I** What else did God promise to Solomon, who sought wisdom for the cause of the people? (11,12)

2-2. **Applying and Sharing |** If you first seek the kingdom of God and its righteousness, God adds all things. (Matthew 6:33) Why would he? (cf. Gen. 18: 18-19)

3-1. **Observation and Meditation** □ The wisdom of Solomon, praised by the kings of neighboring nations, shows the attributes of a kingdom in his reign. (2 Chronicles 9: 7-8)

3-2. **Applying and Sharing |** In my life (ministry) What should I pray for to reveal the kingdom of God?

Telling the Word

Solomon has asked for wisdom and knowledge to judge the just and justice of the people of Israel, not longevity or wealth, but what is needed for the mission as king over God's kingdom, where wisdom is right and wrong Wisdom is the ability to discern all things as God-centered in any field. Putting God First to appear in all areas of my life is to build up the kingdom of God rightly and justly through this wisdom.

Praying with the Word | I will not try to save something outside God 's will. Let my prayer for my own benefit cease and enlarge my heart to pray for the kingdom of God.

Embed in your heart I "Your God loves Israel and set you up forever and ever, and made you king over them to do righteousness and justice" (II Chronicles 9: 8)
