¹⁴ Return to us, God Almighty! Look down from heaven and see! Watch over this vine, ¹⁵ the root your right hand has planted, the son you have raised up for yourself. ¹⁶ Your vine is cut down, it is burned with fire; at your rebuke your people perish. ¹⁷ Let your hand rest on the man at your right hand, the son of man you have raised up for yourself. ¹⁸ Then we will not turn away from you; revive us, and we will call on your name. ¹⁹ Restore us, LORD God Almighty; make your face shine on us, that we may be saved.

Personal Revival “Delight in the LORD”

Psalm 37:1-9

¹ Do not fret because of those who are evil or be envious of those who do wrong; ² for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away. ³ Trust in the LORD and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. ⁴ Take delight in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart. ⁵ Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this: ⁶ He will make your righteous reward shine like the dawn, your vindication like the noonday sun. ⁷ Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. ⁸ Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret—it leads only to evil. ⁹ For those who are evil will be destroyed, but those who hope in the LORD will inherit the land.

Let's Pray Together

- We cannot expect a communal revival without a personal revival. He who trusts and takes delight in the Lord will experience God fulfilling the desires of his heart. Let us earnestly seek God with our whole heart and entrust our way to Him.
- The passage says that anger and fret lead only to evil. Should you struggle with people and circumstances that cause anger and complaint in your heart, let us bring those to the Lord.
- Let us pray for God's justice to flow into the dark sides of our homes and societies and ask God to shine His light like the noonday's sun. Let us also pray for God's life-giving light to shine on the Islamic society that is oppressed by the dark force.

Psalm 119:34-37

³⁴ Give me understanding, so that I may keep your law and obey it with all my heart.

They will be my people, and I will be their God. ²¹ But as for those whose hearts are devoted to their vile images and detestable idols, I will bring down on their own heads what they have done, declares the Sovereign LORD.”

Acts 2:37-47

³⁷ When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?” ³⁸ Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call.” ⁴⁰ With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, “Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.” ⁴¹ Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. ⁴² They devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Let’s Pray Together

- The revival of the early church is not a story in a novel or a movie. It actually happened in history. We can expect to experience this revival even today. Let’s pray that revival like that of the early church will occur once again.
- What’s distinctive in early church revival is sharing. Revival has accelerated as they shared their possessions with their neighbors in need. Let’s pray that all brothers and sisters who are suffering physically, mentally, and economically due to this difficult situation may find hope from the church. Let’s pray further, for the revival of the church, so it can bring hope to the world.
